Who is this training for?

- This is a basic instructor course that is designed to teach basic instructors who want to work with youth. It will cover discipline instruction and range management according to 4-H guidelines. The course covers range procedures, 4-H strategy, equipment, competition, liability, risk management, instructor expectations, and fundraising. Other certifications are available.
- As a certified 4-H instructor, you will be covered by a \$2,000,000 insurance policy.
- No experience necessary
- Trainees from all counties are welcome
- 4-H has competitions throughout the year with a state match in archery, air rifle, muzzleloader, and shotgun.

Other Volunteer Requirements:

- In addition to the basic training, volunteers must complete a 4-H volunteer training that includes a background check. This paperwork will be provided by your home county extension office. Please contact them two weeks before the training.
