
VISION


CENTER OF EXCELLENCE FOR VETERANS STUDENT SUCCESS

The Office of Veteran and Military Affairs was the recipient of a \$450,000 Office of Post-Secondary Education grant over the next three years to establish a Center of Excellence for Veteran Student Success. This funding was provided to increase persistence, retention, and graduation rates of student Veterans at FIU. It will also develop processes and procedures to track employment rates of student Veterans at FIU in partnership with the Office of Career & Talent Development. With this funding, the Office of Veteran and Military Affairs will be able to hire a Program Manager and Academic Coordinator to oversee the outcomes of the Center of Excellence for Veteran Student Success. Additionally, this project will develop a model program to support veteran student success in postsecondary education by coordinating services to address the academic, financial, physical, and social needs of Veteran students.

Career and Talent Development's Veteran Career Success (VCS) is a professional development program that aims to assist all FIU veteran students and alumni achieve career success; through resume and cover letter writing, job search help, financial planning, career readiness and professional development.

Being in the military is an exceptional experience which brings a lot of exposure to different skills and competences that might be different from the traditional student.

Therefore, translating these experiences to civilian language is imperative on each Veterans career journey as employers value these skills. The VCS program not only aims to educate and guide Veterans on their career path but also provide campus wide resources to ease their transition and therefore, educational life at FIU.





Academy of Leaders - Veterans Track

GREEN ZONE TRAINING

There are over 1,100 students at Florida International University (FIU) who identify as active duty, veteran, reservist, or National Guard members. These students are in every program and bring significant life experiences and diversity to the FIU community. Green Zone Training provides faculty and staff with an understanding of student veterans as they transition from the military to campus life.

During this Green Zone Training, participants will learn about:

- 1. A basic understanding of what it means to be a student veteran at FIU;
- 2. Military cultural competencies;
- 3. Services and resources provided by the Office of Veteran and Military Affairs;
- 4. Common myths/stigmas surrounding student veterans;
- 5. Off-campus resources and support services;
- 6. Issues and concerns faced by student veterans and military affiliated students; and
- 7. Lending an empathetic ear and help our student veterans and military-affiliated students connect with the appropriate resources.



RETENTION AND COMPLETION SCHOLARSHIP

The **George & Bernice Cooke Scholarship** is available to all Veterans, active duty, reservists, and National Guard members enrolled at FIU. This scholarship will be awarded to undergraduate and graduate students enrolled in or accepted for admission to the University.

Eligibility Requirements

- Recipients must be degree-seeking Veterans, active duty, reservists, and National Guard members enrolled at FIU enrolled for a minimum of three credit hours per semester.
- Recipients must demonstrate financial need by completing the national Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Recipients must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA.
- Recipients must be US citizens or permanent residents.
- Recipients may renew the award contingent upon eligibility and submission of applications in Spring and Fall semester





FIU has partnered with Kognito in order to offer this free veteran training module to all FIU students, faculty and staff. Kognito's offers role-play simulations will enable you to rapidly build the capacity to lead real-life conversations that change lives. In this simulation you will learn to support student veterans by building military cultural competency. In this virtual practice environment, you'll engage in simulated conversations with three virtual student veterans, helping each one resolve a challenge they are facing due to their transition.


