**Registration**

Registration for the shoot will be live on 4-H Online July 8. Online registration deadline is July 28. <https://v2.4honline.com/#/user/sign-in> You will need to indicate the county youth will represent and events. Your times will be assigned and sent to you in advance.

**Payment**

Match fee for three match events \$65 or a single event is flat fee of \$40. Payments can be made on 4-H Online. No registration after July 28.

**Eligibility**

Shotgun will be open to all junior and senior participants (11 and older as of December 31, 2023). Youth may shoot up in the senior division if they will be old enough (14) by the date to be eligible the national competition. Participants must be enrolled 4-H members and have passed North Dakota Hunter Education.

**Location and Event Info**

All match events will follow the ND 4-H State Match Rules available on the 4-H Website. All events will be held at Capital City Sporting Clays Range near Menoken on Saturday. Seniors will shoot 100 trap targets, 50 sporting clays and 50 skeet targets. Juniors will shoot 100 trap targets, 50 skeet targets and 50 sporting clays. You may opt to only participate in the trap event. Scoring mirrors the system used at the 4-H National Championships.

**National Qualification**

Those senior teams wishing to qualify for the 2024 National Championships must shoot all three events and be the combined highest scoring team or state. Generally, the three top scoring members of the state champion team and the state champion may comprise the national team for 2025.

The National Team will not be announced during this event. It will be reviewed and decided upon the week following the event. National team will be based on a youth's shooting skills, attitude and sportsmanship and other's recommendations.

Contacts will be made with county staff prior to the announcement of the national team being selection becoming finalized.

**Check In**

Trap check in will begin at 8:30am on Saturday, August 10. You will be assigned a shooting time in advance and those times will be sent out via email to you, your county Extension Office and

also posted on the North Dakota 4-H Shooting Sports Facebook page. Relays will begin at 9:00am.



### **Shooting Times**

- Shooting times will be assigned.
- Trap will consist of four rounds of 25.
- Skeet will consist of two rounds of 25.
- Sporting Clays will consist of one round of 50 shots.
- Sporting Clays will be on the sporting clays course.

### **Dress and Equipment**

- 4-H T shirt, hearing protection, and eye protection are required.
- Shorts must be neat and not torn are acceptable.
- Please bring all supplies with you including:
- vest or pouch, ammunition and firearm, ECI

### **Shoot Offs**

- Shoot offs will not be held. Ties will be broken by the longest run of shot targets in reverse order.
- Ties will only be broken if it involves the top five individuals.
