Acute Uncomplicated Bronchitis

Routine treatment of uncomplicated acute bronchitis with antibiotics is **not recommended**, regardless of cough duration.

Options for symptomatic therapy include:

1. Cough suppressants (dextromethorphan)

2.First-generation antihistamines (diphenhydramine)

3. Decongestants (phenylephrine)
