<a href="#">Phi Kappa Phi Faculty Lectureship Award</a> Deadline: 10/4/24	Recognizes faculty whose outstanding and high-impact research, scholarship, or creative activity consistently supports NDSU's top tier research status and who have a proven ability to effectively present their research to a broad community in the land grant tradition. Lecture will be held in December 2024. Two to three finalists will be interviewed for the lectureship. <b>Award amount:</b> \$2,500 ( <i>up to two finalists receive \$500</i> ) <b>Submit:</b> Nomination letter (one letter, no more than 2 pages long) and CV (no more than three pages long)
<a href="#">Jordan A. Engberg Presidential Professorship</a> Deadline: 10/25/24	Recognizes excellence in teaching, research, and service. <b>Eligibility:</b> Full professor with at least eight years of service to NDSU <b>Award amount:</b> \$6,500 <b>Submit:</b> Nomination letter (one letter, no more than two pages long) and CV (no more than three pages long)

<p><b><u>Walter F. and Verna Gehrts Presidential Professorship</u></b> Deadline: 10/25/24</p>	<p>Recognizes excellence in teaching, research, and service. <b>Eligibility:</b> Associate professor with at least five years of service to NDSU <b>Award amount:</b> \$6,500 <b>Submit:</b> Nomination letter (one letter, no more than two pages long) and CV (no more than three pages long)</p>
<p><b><u>Dale Hogoboom Presidential Professorship</u></b> Deadline: 10/25/24</p>	<p>Recognizes excellence in teaching, research, and service. <b>Eligibility:</b> Full professor with at least eight years of service to NDSU <b>Award amount:</b> \$6,500 <b>Submit:</b> Nomination letter (one letter, no more than two pages long) and CV (no more than three pages long)</p>
<p><b><u>Faculty Lectureship Award</u></b> Deadline: 12/13/24</p>	<p>Recognizes sustained excellence in teaching, scholarly achievement, and service. One of the oldest and most prestigious awards. Lecture will be held in April 2025. <b>Award amount:</b> \$2,500 (<i>up to two finalists receive \$500</i>) <b>Submit:</b> Nomination letter (one letter, no more than two pages long) and CV (no more than three pages long). Two to three finalists will be interviewed.</p>
<p><b><u>Odney Excellence in Teaching Award</u></b> Deadline: 1/31/25</p>	<p>Honors faculty members who have consistently demonstrated outstanding teaching and made positive contributions to the educational experience of NDSU students. <i>Students and alumni submit nominations.</i> <b>Award amount:</b> \$2,500 <b>Submit:</b> <a href="#">Nomination form</a>. Finalists will be asked to submit their CV and a letter explaining their teaching philosophy and detailing their teaching activities.</p>
<p><b><u>Waldron Excellence in Research Award</u></b> Deadline: 1/31/25</p>	<p>Honors faculty members who have consistently demonstrated outstanding achievements and contributions to research and scholarship. <b>Award amount:</b> \$2,500 <b>Submit:</b> Nomination letter (one letter, no more than two pages long) and CV (no more than three pages long)</p>
<p><b><u>Peltier Innovation in Teaching Award</u></b> Deadline: 1/31/25</p>	<p>Recognizes faculty who have used innovative teaching techniques to enhance the educational experiences of NDSU students. Group nominations accepted. <b>Award amount:</b> \$5,000 <b>Submit:</b> Nomination letter (one letter, no more than two pages long). Finalists will be asked to submit their CV and a letter detailing their innovative techniques.</p>
<p><b><u>Excellence in Mentoring Award</u></b> Deadline: 2/22/25</p>	<p>Recognizes outstanding mentoring by faculty of undergraduate/graduate students, faculty, and others. <i>Students, staff, and faculty submit nominations.</i> <b>Award amount:</b> \$2,500 <b>Submit:</b> Nomination letter (one letter, no more than two pages long), CV (no more than three pages long), and letters of support from mentees (up to two)</p>
<p><b><u>Chamber of Commerce NDSU Distinguished Faculty Service Award</u></b> Deadline: 2/22/25</p>	<p>Recognizes faculty members who have attained distinction in their profession and have made substantial service contributions to the community and region. <b>Eligibility:</b> Faculty holding the rank of full professor <b>Award amount:</b> \$2,500 <b>Submit:</b> Nomination letter (one letter, no more than two pages long), CV (no more than three pages long), and letters of support (up to two).</p>
<p><b><u>Outstanding Faculty Advisor Award</u></b> Deadline: 2/22/25</p>	<p>Recognizes faculty advisors who have demonstrated a commitment to empowering students, fostering their academic and personal growth, and guiding them toward reaching their full potential. <b>Eligibility:</b> Faculty advisor at NDSU who has advised students for at least six months and not received this award in the previous three years. <i>Students and alumni submit nominations.</i></p>

	<p><b>Award amount:</b> \$1,000  <b>Submit:</b> <a href="#">Nomination form</a></p>
<p><b><u>Outstanding Professional Advisor Award</u></b>  Deadline: <i>2/22/25</i></p>	<p>Recognizes professional advisors who have demonstrated a commitment to empowering students, fostering their academic and personal growth, and guiding them toward reaching their full potential.  <b>Eligibility:</b> Professional advisor at NDSU who has advised students for at least six months and not received this award in the previous three years. <i>Students and alumni submit nominations.</i>  <b>Award amount:</b> \$1,000  <b>Submit:</b> <a href="#">Nomination form</a></p>
<p><b><u>Service Learning Award</u></b>  Deadline: <i>2/22/25</i></p>	<p>Recognizes the impact of instructional faculty who have integrated academic learning with meaningful community engagement through service learning.  <b>Eligibility:</b> Faculty and lecturers  <b>Award amount:</b> \$1,000  <b>Submit:</b> Nomination letter, course syllabus and/or assignment sheets, and letters of support from community partner(s).</p>
