In 2012, the NDSU Concert Choir won the 8th Annual International Choir Competition in Zadar, Croatia.

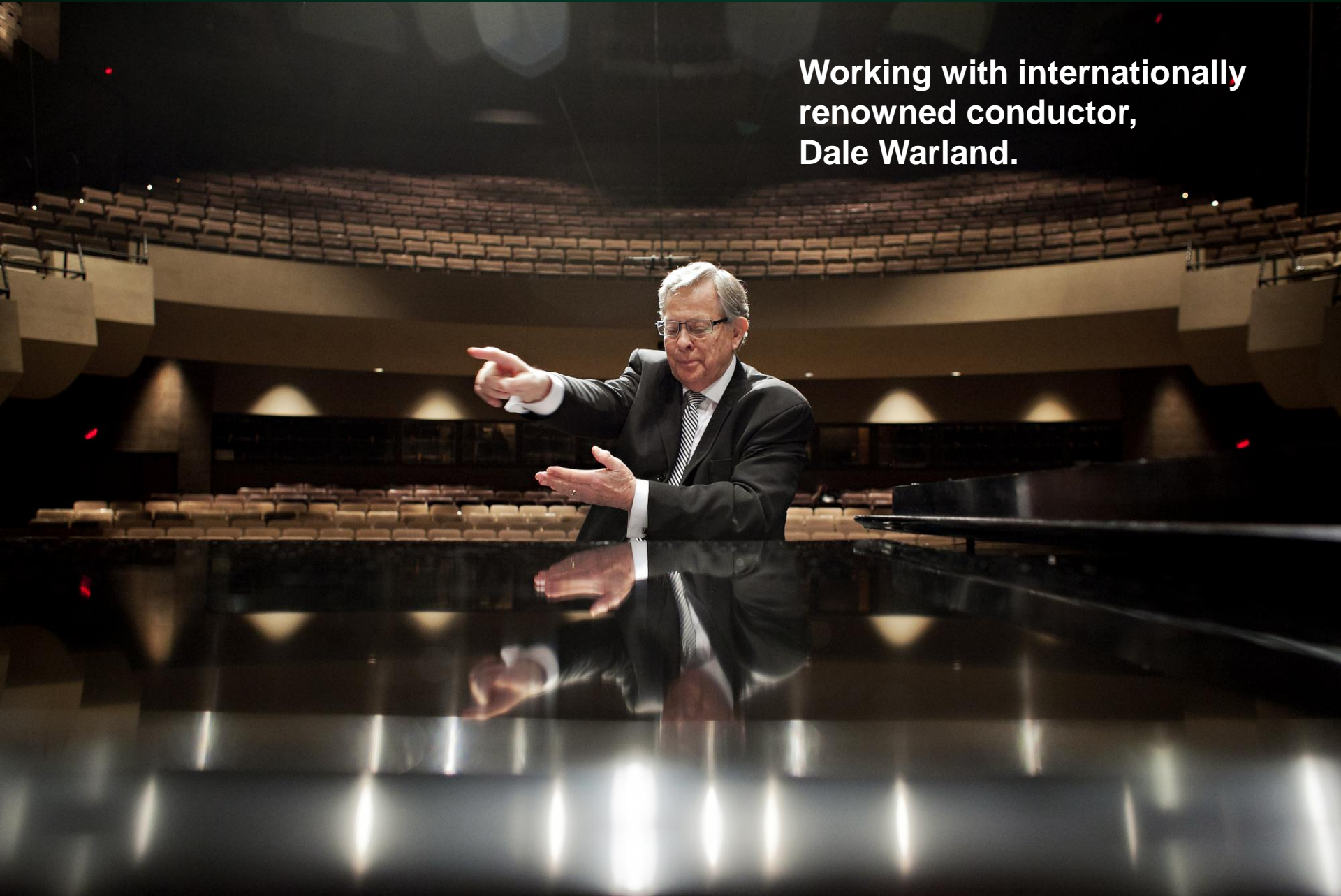

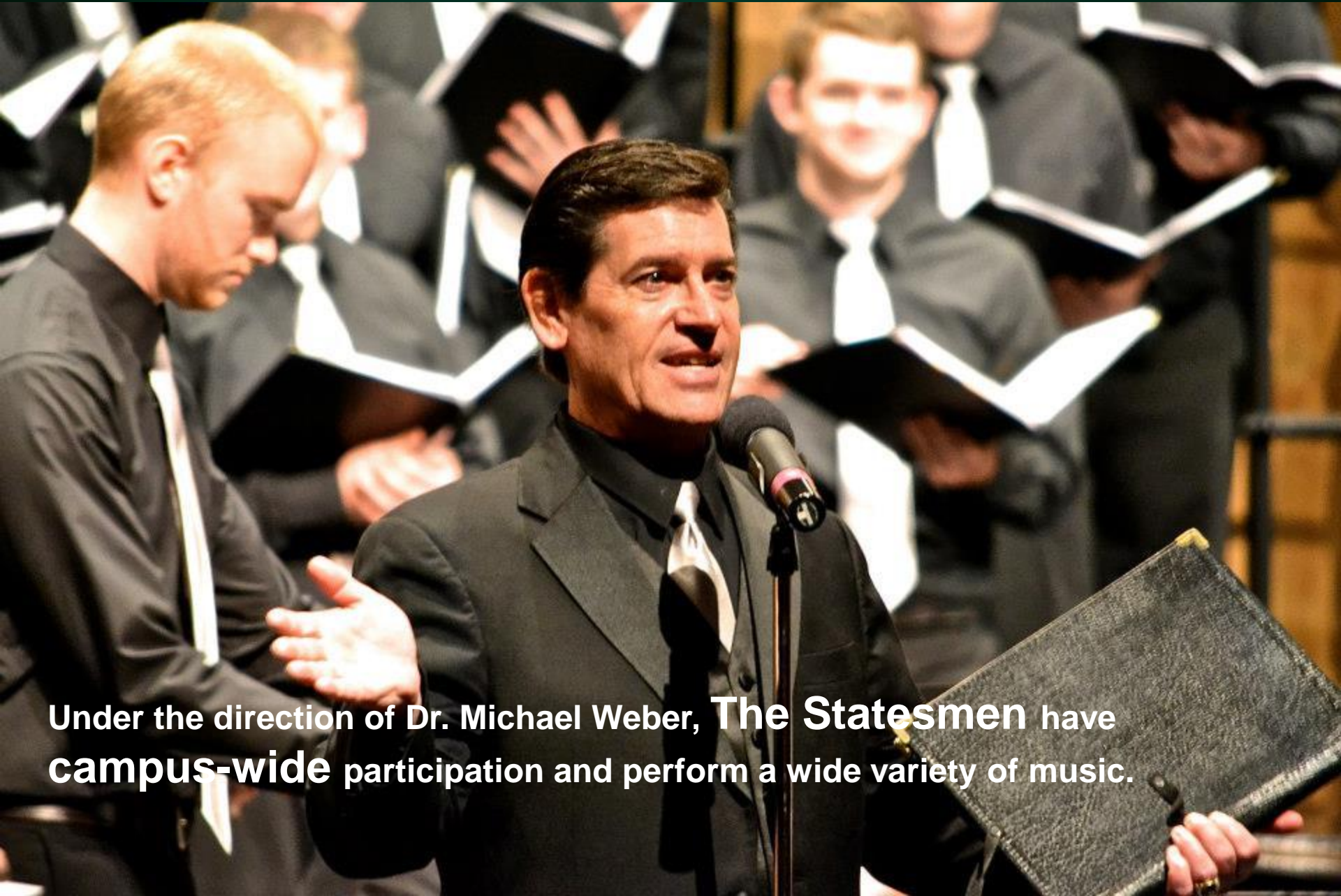
