

# Spring Grant Aid Application and Guidelines All Materials Due to Ceres 338 by Dec. 6, 2024

Only signed, paper applications will be accepted.

Online and late applications will not be considered.

### Student Support Services (SSS) Grant Aid is a financial award available to eligible SSS

**participants.** SSS Grant Aid is provided by the Office of TRIO Programs through a grant from the U.S. Department of Education. The aim of the grant is to support the educational pursuits of SSS participants at North Dakota State University (NDSU). Award notification will go out on Jan. 10<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Eligibility Requirements for SSS Grant Aid:**

- Be a current and active SSS participant ('active' defined as 'using SSS services').
- Receive a Federal Pell Grant in the 2024-25 academic year.
- Be in good academic standing.
- Students earning D's or F's as a final grade for Fall 2024 classes need to meet with SSS Project Director Scott Norenberg to avoid denial of Grant Aid.
- Be enrolled and attending classes at NDSU for Spring 2025.
- Complete two financial literacy courses found at: <a href="https://smartwithmymoney.nd.gov/courses">https://smartwithmymoney.nd.gov/courses</a> and save/screen shot certificate earned at completion.

#### **Application Materials:**

- A complete 2024/25 Grant Aid Cover Sheet (page 2 of this document).
- Proof of completion of financial literacy courses (print-outs/ photos of certificates)
- Attach a <u>1-2 paragraph</u> essay that addresses:
  - a. How TRIO SSS has helped you in succeeding at NDSU.
  - b. How the aid will assist you in successfully completing your college degree.

#### **Awarding Requirements/Information:**

- Student must have an unmet financial need as determined by SSS. Students with greater need are given priority.
- Students must be in their first 2 years of postsecondary education.
- NDSU's Tuition Award Program may have a drastic impact on the ability of SSS to provide awards to grant aid-eligible students.

Due to limited funds available, not all applicants are guaranteed SSS Grant Aid.
