


# ND Structural Organization Soil Conservation Districts



## **Conservation Partner Roles at the State Level**

Our conservation partnership works because each of the core partners is accountable to contribute specific attributes. Listed below are some general responsibilities state partners assume.

### **NRCS**

- Training for district/agency staff (Technical and Programs)
- Funding to address resource concerns as identified by district/local workgroup
- Conduct the State Technical Committee function (including district and state agency participation)
- Coordinate with and support districts in the executing local workgroup activity/responsibilities
- Administer federal programs
- Provide framework for conservation planning functions
- Coordinator with district boards on conservation plan and practice approvals
- Ensure engagement of conservation districts and discussions of participant specific activity complies with Sections 1619 and Section 1244 provisions protecting confidentiality of records
- Share resources with districts/agencies
- Technical standards and assistance

### **State Soil Conservation Committee**

- Administrate State Appropriated Funding for districts wages/salaries
- Training for district boards/staff (Programs and Administrative)
- Coordination between districts
- Request and manage legislative budget appropriations for conservation
- Serve on State Technical Committee

### **Conservation Districts**

- Combine funds from varied sources to implement conservation practices/programs
- Develop long range and annual plans to address local concerns
- Utilize conservation planning process
- Conservation education/outreach
- Identify opportunities and build partnerships around local natural resource issues
- Host and manage local workgroup meetings and processes

### **Conservation District Employees Association**

- Promote professional development
- Support and implement conservation district long range and annual plans of operation including local district programs
- Carry out technical assistance, conservation education and outreach work including conservation planning
- Share resources/tools/techniques

### **State Association of Soil Conservation Districts**

- Coordination between districts
- Represent and provide political support for districts/state agency
- Represent districts at the state/territory level
- Serve on State Technical Committees
- Unified voice for conservation districts
- Provide non-profit status benefits
