Dear State Board of Agricultural Research and Education Board Members:

The Cavalier County Job Development Association board members would like to provide testimony in support of a much-needed modernized foundation seed conditioning facility to be located on the campus of the Langdon Research Extension Center (LREC). The LREC's nine-county service area supports a high level of cropping systems agriculture where demand for seed is very high. In addition, recent changes in cropping system enterprises require modernized seed conditioning equipment. Finally, scale weighing upgrades as demanded by the North Dakota Public Service Commissioner make it imperative to complete this effort soon.

The region served by the LREC produces the highest level of registered and certified seed in ND. Much of that seed is dependent on foundation grade seed coming from the LREC. The LREC foundation seed program has been in existence since 1962 and has sold foundation grade seed to over 133 growers and/or other seedsman in just the last 10 years. A new conditioning plant will allow this mission to continue into the future.

In the last seven years our region's producers have added peas, faba beans, dry beans and soybeans to their rotations. Unfortunately, the old conditioning plant at the LREC is unable to condition peas, soybeans, faba beans and other pulse crops. A new conditioning facility would allow conditioning of all crops demanded by growers in our region.

A recent inspection from the North Dakota Public Service Commission revealed the 50-foot scale currently used by the LREC for foundation seed sales is non-compliant with today's standards (for weighing semis). The LREC was given a five-year waiver allowing them to legally split weigh semis. After five years the scale must be increased to 80 feet long. The \$200,000 cost to bring the scale into compliance may not be worth the expenditure if the seed conditioning plant is not modernized.

The Cavalier County Job Development Authority board members unanimously support this project and ask that SBARE consider this as a high priority for North Dakota agriculture. The Cavalier County Strategic Plan includes seven benchmarks, one of which is agriculture. Projects like this ensure that the plan's goals of continued growth and meeting the needs of local producers are met.
